

# "Ingredients (for a successful Motion recipe)"

Conceive and create an animation which must be exactly thirty-eight seconds long based on a word list and a soundtrack.

Word list (only the words in bold type must appear):

- Title : Ingredients (for a successful Motion recipe)
- · Nice drawings / Beautiful photos / Neat videos / Relevant typographies / Strong audio
- · Tagline : Give taste to messages!

### Soundtracks (just pick one):

- Starsailor Four To The Floor (Thin White Duke Mix 3Cl Edit)
- Rone Motion (3CI Edit)

#### STEP 1 - Graphic universe :

Materialize these feelings and images in order to formalize a graphic universe (colors, shapes, images, typography...). This will form the visual vocabulary of your film.

## STEP 2 - Storyboard:

Create a storyboard. That step will clarify your visual narration: rearrange shots, anticipate framings, imagine transitions... This is the visual representation of the technical breakdown (kind of your visual grammar).

#### STEP 3 - Production/Realization :

Feel free to use whichever technique you want (painting, drawing, photography, digital illustration...) to set up the identity of your project. We will then define together the best way to achieve your work and see the central role of After Effects and how to optimize it.

#### Goals:

Learn and experiment how to manipulate, create, assemble and synchronize with the audio, visual elements (from vector graphics to live action footage) mainly in Adobe After Effects but also with its related softwares such as Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Premiere Pro and Adobe Audition...

Graphic files must be at 72 dpi and in RVB mode.

- Graphic concept and creativity.
- Audio synchronization.
- Technical constraints.
